Acrylic or oil paints, palette paper

- Brand is your option – a good starter set or your favorite colors
- Favorite brands are Windsor and Newton, Golden, Holbein, Ultrrecht, Liquitex, Sennelier
- For oils try the water-based ones for easier cleanup
- Bring disposable palette paper

Suggestions for colors

- Sap Green
- Olive Green
- Burnt Sienna
- Raw Umber
- Rose
- Alizarin Crimson
- White, Black
- Yellow
- Orange
- Violet
- Ultramarine Blue
- Indigo blue
- Cobalt or Cerulean Blue

Brushes and palette knives

- Brushes for acrylic or oil – large, medium and small sizes
- Palette Knives – small and medium

Paper and/or canvas – if using oils the canvas must be treated. If buying paper get the thicker 300 gsm mixed media paper or hot press

Cleaning supplies

- Paper towels, solvent for oils that are not water soluble (turpentine)
- Favorite landscape photos for reference. Can be paper or digital.
